The Life Charity offers counselling and housing support to expectant mothers.

This Tuesday: Devotions to the Holy Face

One of our projects during the pandemic was the restoration and reframing of our painting of the Holy Face of Jesus, which is a copy of the original by Franz Ittenbach (1813-1879), a German painter of the Nazarene school. In the mid-nineteenth century, especially in France, there was a flowering of devotion to the Holy Face, which was taken up by SS. Louis and Zélie Martin, the parents of St Thérèse of the Child Jesus and the Holy Face. It was the founder of our parish, Charles Robertson, who donated the painting to us in 1914. **This Tuesday, Shrove Tuesday, at 6.00 pm we shall have a Votive Mass (in the Latin Extraordinary Form) of the Holy Face, followed by special prayers.**

This Tuesday: Prayer Group

The prayer group, started and led by parishioners, will be meeting this Tuesday, 17th, at 7:30 pm. The meeting includes Evening Prayer and intercessions (held in the Presbytery sitting room). All are welcome.

***This Wednesday – Ash Wednesday:
Day of Fasting and Abstinence***

- **Fasting** on Ash Wednesday means that **all adults (those aged 18 to 60) are obliged to fast**. This means having only one complete meal, with other food taken during the day amounting to less than one complete meal. **This law does not apply to the sick, nor to expectant and nursing mothers.**
- **Abstinence** means abstaining from meat or, for vegetarians, some other principal food. **Abstinence is for those over 14, not for younger children.** We fast and abstain as an act of penance motivated by love of our Lord Jesus Christ, who fasted and was crucified for our salvation.

This Thursday: Talk on Consecration to Our Lady

The 33-Day preparation for the Consecration to Our Lady on the feast of the Annunciation begins this Friday, 20th February. There will be an introductory talk in the Glass Room at **7 pm this Thursday, 19th**. In the narthex you will find the CTS booklet, *33 Day Consecration to Jesus through Mary*, by John Pridmore and Niall Slattery, with prayers and readings, price £4.95.

Lent Begins - Time for Confession

There are several additional times for Confession this week, several of them with visiting priests. **Every Catholic has the obligation to go to Confession at least once a year. The best time to fulfil the obligation is Lent.**

Lenten almsgiving

- Our parish Lenten alms will once again be given to Aid to the Church in Need for its work in the Middle East and

Ukraine. The 2025 *World Watch List*, published by Open Doors, said that, although Christianity is the world's largest religion, with 2.3 billion adherents and continued growth, one in seven Christians face persecution. The report said this figure rises to one in five in Africa and two in five in Asia.

- By way of almsgiving, you might like also to contribute to the **Food Bank** boxes (for the Cuttleslowe Community Larder) in the narthex or Presbytery porch. Donations must be dry goods only. Why not bring a couple of items with you to Mass on Sundays?

A piano for Uganda: A Lenten challenge for St Gregory's

- Our parishioner Paul Lokubal tells me that St Mary's Seminary in Nadiket, Uganda, is in urgent need of a piano. A suitable instrument, the Yamaha CVP 701, costs about £3000. I invite parishioners to make donations to cover this cost. **If you would like to donate by card, you will find a dedicated button on the card-reader marked 'Piano Project'.**
- The Church in Africa is spiritually rich, with packed churches and many vocations to the priesthood, but materially poor. The Guinean Cardinal, Robert Sarah, not long ago made this stirring affirmation of Catholic Africa's fidelity to Christ: The Church in Africa, he said, will 'firmly oppose any rebellion against the teaching of Jesus and the Magisterium'.
