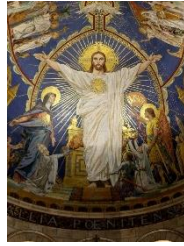

June - The Month of the Sacred Heart

The month of June is devoted to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, as is every First Friday of the month. During these last few days of June, please say each day, 'Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, have mercy on us', or 'O Heart of Love, I place all my trust in you, for while I fear all things from my weakness, I hope for all things from your mercy.'

July – The Month of the Precious Blood

The month of July is traditionally devoted to the Precious Blood of Jesus. Each day you could say the beautiful prayer inscribed above the entrance to Westminster Cathedral (the Cathedral of the Precious Blood): *Domine Jesu, rex et redemptor, per sanguinem tuum salva nos.* 'Lord Jesus, King and Redeemer, through your Precious Blood, save us!'

The Sacred Heart of Jesus is a symbol of that divine love which He shares with the Father and the Holy Spirit but which He, the Word made flesh, alone manifests through a weak and perishable body, since 'in Him dwells the fullness of the Godhead bodily'.

It is also the symbol of that burning charity which, infused into His soul, enriches the human will of Christ and enlightens and governs its acts by the most perfect knowledge derived both from the beatific vision and that knowledge which is directly infused.

And finally ...it is the symbol of affectionate love, since the body of Jesus Christ, formed by the Holy Spirit in the womb of the Virgin Mary, possesses full powers of feeling and perception, in fact, more so than any other human body.
