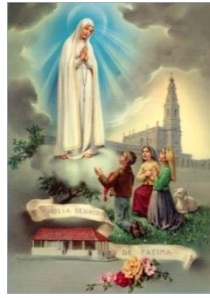

***Assisted Suicide: The battle continues***

On Wednesday this week, MPs and Peers will return to Westminster for a new session, and MPs will then have just over a week to enter a ballot from which twenty Private Members' Bills will be drawn. Kim Leadbeater's allies are determined to resurrect her Assisted Suicide bill. There is talk of packing a Commons committee to avoid amendments and using the Parliament Acts to bypass the Lords. **Please urge your MP not to bring forward a new Assisted Suicide Private Members' Bill, and not to support tactics aimed at bypassing Parliamentary scrutiny.**
